**Crown Royal Black - Blended Canadian Whiskey**      a bold Canadian blend rested in used bourbon barrels

## Single Malt Scotch Whiskey

<b>Balvinie 12 yr</b>	<b>9</b>	Highland- medium rich body, warm finish
<b>Dalwhinnie</b>	<b>14</b>	Highland- light peat, smooth lasting flavor, long finish
<b>Cragganmore</b>	<b>9</b>	Highland- light to medium, firm, smooth, malty with a hint of peat
<b>Glennfiddich</b>	<b>9</b>	Highland- light, lean smooth, fruity dash of water brings out a hint of smoke
<b>The Glenlivet 12yr</b>	<b>9</b>	Highland- earthy, sherry-ish
<b>Glenmorangie</b>	<b>8</b>	Highland- medium, mainly sweet, creamy
<b>Lagavulin 16</b>	<b>13</b>	Islay- sea salt, peat, long powerful smoke finish
<b>Laphroig 10</b>	<b>8</b>	Islay- medicinal nose, taste of seaweed, salty, round dry finish
<b>McCallan 12yr</b>	<b>12</b>	Highland- sherry, honey, smooth full well rounded
<b>Singleton</b>	<b>9</b>	Highland- good intro to single malt, sherry, very smooth long finish
<b>Talisker</b>	<b>11</b>	Islay- Isle of Skye, amber red color, full body, slightly syrupy, papery finish
<b>Cardhu</b>	<b>10</b>	Speyside - full-flavored, ripe pears, sophisticated palate, pleasant smoothness and crisp

## Bourbons and American Whiskey

<b>Knob Creek</b>	<b>9</b>	Copper color, toasted nuts, grain oak, full bodied- long, rich finish Awarded national champion whiskey
<b>Basil Hayden</b>	<b>7.5</b>	Golden Amber, spice, hint of peppermint, spicy, light bodied gentle Bite, dry clean finish. Awarded silver medal button
<b>Bookers</b>	<b>9.25</b>	Deep, rich , smokey amber, color with big oak, vanilla smell, intense tannin tobacco taste finishing long & clean. Awarded gold medal bourbon
<b>Baker's</b>	<b>9</b>	Nut brown color with fruit vanilla, caramel with a taste of toasted nuts, fruit & vanilla, finishing medium long, smooth & super sweet awarded gold medal bourbon
<b>Gentleman Jack</b>	<b>8</b>	Twice mellowed through 10 feet of sugar maple charcoal. A rich, full flavor with hints of fruits and spices
<b>Jack Daniel's Single Barrel</b>	<b>10</b>	A rich aroma, deep color and complex character. Bold with notes of sweet vanilla caramels and a nice oak finish
<b>Jefferson's Reserve</b>	<b>10</b>	Rich walnut in color with fruit-cake-like-nose. A huge body with a well balanced fruity/spicy palate hinting of pears, cinnamon, dates, raisins and sweet butter Full, long, fruity finish. A sipping whiskey
<b>Blanton's</b>	<b>8.75</b>	Deep golden color, sweet start going dry quickly creamy roundness, corn and rye. Smooth whisper at the finish. Snifter only! No water.
<b>Woodford Reserve</b>	<b>10</b>	Dark orange color, very firm. Full of flowers, with light almond, smells of cigar boxes with a very long finish
<b>1792</b>	<b>7</b>	distinctively smooth, handcrafted small-batch bourbon, patiently aged 8 years in new charred oak barrels
<b>Makers Mark</b>	<b>8</b>	Full, yet delicate; well-rounded; possessing a distinctive caramel aroma of the charred oak with a hint of vanilla

## Classic Drinks

<b>Sazarac</b>	<b>8</b>	An Original from the the 1800's If you don't know it..try it
<b>Dark and Stormy</b>	<b>8</b>	Classic Highball with two great tastes of the tropics
<b>Manhattan</b>	<b>9</b>	One of the oldest and finest made with Rye at Ormsby's
<b>Old Fashioned</b>	<b>9</b>	The perfect ideal of what a cocktail should contain: a spirit, a sweet. a bitter. a sour and water. Disputably the first drink referred to as a cocktail.
<b>Negroni</b>	<b>8</b>	A classic Italian aperitif. The best thing about this Campari drink is that the sweet vermouth offsets the bitterness of the Italian spirit.
<b>Satan's Whiskers</b>	<b>8</b>	The mix of flavors is quite pleasant but potent. Said to <i>"Have Curled the Whiskers of Satan Himself"</i>

## Brewery Operated Distilled Spirits

<b>Hazelnut Spiced Rum – Rogue Distillery</b>	<b>8.5</b>	Toasted hazelnut flavor with orange overtones and rich vanilla scents mingled with cinnamon and clove.
<b>Dead Guy Whiskey – Rogue Distillery</b>	<b>8.5</b>	Made with the same four grains used to make Rogue Dead Guy Ale. Delicately sweet with rich, malt complexity, opens up to a warm, peppery finish.
<b>Pink Spruce Gin – Rogue Distillery</b>	<b>8.5</b>	Ocean aged in Oregon Pinot Noir barrels resulting in a slightly fruity, mellow, and definitely Pink Gin. Spruce, Cucumber, angelica root, orange peel, coriander, lemon peel, ginger, otis root, grains of paradise, tangerine, juniper berries.
<b>Junipero Gin – Anchor Distillery</b>	<b>9</b>	The formula remains a secret. Light, crisp, and clean, combining a deep and mysterious spiciness with subtle delicacy.
